Forest Service Seeking Applicants to Operate and Maintain Two National Forest Recreation Sites

Eagle River, Wis. – August 27, 2004. The Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest is soliciting applications for two special-use permits to provide high quality public service in the operation and maintenance of government owned facilities at the Lac Vieux Desert Campground in Vilas County and the Lost Lake Recreation Cabins in Florence County.

The Lac Vieux Desert Campground is located 20 miles north of Eagle River, Wisconsin via State Highway 45, County Road E and West Shore Road.

The Lost Lake Recreation Cabins are located 17 miles west of Florence, Wisconsin via State Highway 70 and 3 miles south on Forest Road 2450 and Forest Road 2156.
