## FOREST ROADS ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.54(d) and (f), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions herein after set forth apply to all roads within the Ozark-St. Francis National Forests. This closure is effective until December 31, 2026 or rescinded by an authorized Forest Official, whichever occurs first.

- 1. Using a road for commercial hauling without a permit or authorization. (36 CFR 261.54(c))
- 2. Operating any motorized vehicle on a Forest System Road in violation of State Law. (36 CFR 261.54(d))
- 3. Operating any motorized vehicle carelessly, recklessly or without regard for the rights and safety of other persons or in a manner or at a speed that would endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. (36 CFR 261.54(f))

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
