Sulphur Ranger District**

**National Forest System Area & Trail Closure**

Pursuant to Title 16, United States Code (U.S.C.) §551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) §261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land on the Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest, Grand County, State of Colorado. The Restricted Area is located in T2 S, R75 W, in portions of Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8.

The restricted closure period will be September 10, 2019 to December 15, 2019. This Order is necessary to provide for safety of the public during Logging activities. The Restricted Areas and Trail Segments are shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as "Exhibit A".

Trails with Restrictions include

N73 – D3  
N74 – D4  
N74.1 – Leap Frog  
N74.2 – Take D'Leap

**PROHIBITIONS:**

When provided by an order, the following are prohibited:

1. Being in the Restricted Areas. (36 CFR §261.53(e))
2. Being upon the Restricted Trails adjacent to the Restricted Area. (36 CFR §261.55(a))

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR §261.50(e)(1))
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR §261.50(e)(4))

Done in Fort Collins, CO. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or December 15, 2019, whichever occurs first.
