

The Accomplishments:



Northwest Forest Pass:

The Northwest Forest Pass is sold locally as a service to the public, however it is not required at any Malheur National Forest site.

Campgrounds:



- Campground Hosts at 3 campgrounds
- Major hazardous tree removal projects at 2 campgrounds, routine hazard tree removal at the other campgrounds
- Delineated and graveled campsites at 2 campgrounds
- Collection of trash during hunting season
- Increased presence of employees including weekends during holidays and special events
- 8 new fire rings installed
- 8 new picnic tables installed
- Materials purchased to build new tables to be installed next year
- Buck and pole fence repaired and 2 pipe gates installed at horse corrals
- Removed a hazardous water tank that was a public safety issue
- Repaired damage to 1 toilet building
