


Community Engagement:

3. More/better trained workforce trained in communication
4. Reprioritize resources in support of engagement
5. Make collaboration the way we do business/operating philosophy
6. Cultivate appreciation and understanding of differing organizations/cultures
7. Emphasize commonalities and embrace common interest
8. Identify and follow through on maintaining the engagement
9. Be flexible in getting to objectives



2. Better information/assessment of 3 legs (spheres) tied to culture.




Promote Healthy Lifestyles

- Walk the walk – invest, provide examples, trail of the month
- Talk the talk – communicate principle, educate
- Continue to provide accessibility
- Take kids out – role model so kids feel comfortable
- Communities have more, regular activities
- Know and utilize all resources and outreach – grants, elders, organizations
- Incentivize getting out – rain gear, snow shoes, dogs
- Increase access – gear, facilities and trails, activities
- Education – where are trails? What activities are there? What to watch out for, prepare?

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


Connecting People with Nature

- Reaching out, not reaching in
- Convening a lead organization to coordinate external activities and liaison with the FS
- Promoting and selecting staff that embrace it

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Part of a Larger Landscape – All Lands, All Hands
