Wolf Creek Access Analysis Ends

MONTE VISTA – The Rio Grande National Forest plans to officially close out the analysis of the access to the proposed Village at Wolf Creek.

“We have not received a new application from Leavell-McCombs Joint Venture requesting access across the Forest, so we released the analysis team members,” said Jeni Evans, deputy forest supervisor for the San Luis Valley Public Lands Center.

To officially close out the project, the Forest will submit a statement to the Federal Register withdrawing the Notice of Intent to prepare an environmental impact statement analyzing the access. If, in the future, the Forest receives a new proposal from Leavell-McCombs Joint Venture, the Forest will evaluate and consider the next steps at that time.

“I want to thank the team members and the cooperating agencies for all the great work they did up to this point,” said Forest Supervisor, Dan Dallas.

“I also want to thank the public for their continued participation in helping to identify issues concerning the proposed access,” added Dallas.
