Continental Reservoir Boat Ramp Closed for the Season

CREEDE - The boat ramp at Continental Reservoir will be closed to the public after Labor Day weekend and will remain closed for the remainder of the season. The gravel boat ramp is being upgraded to a concrete ramp in order to minimize erosion and sedimentation.

Fishing will be restricted to the shoreline of the reservoir while the boat ramp is being constructed. A new vault toilet will also be installed during the construction project.

The boat ramp project is one of several planned by the Colorado Division of Wildlife (CDOW) on the Forest. CDOW uses a motor boat access fund to build ramps to improve public access and reduce sedimentation at unimproved access ramps.

Continental Reservoir is located southwest of Spring Creek Pass on the Divide Ranger District of the Rio Grande National Forest. The reservoir encompasses approximately 715 acres at an elevation of 10,300 feet. Fishing is generally very good all year, but winter access usually requires the use of snowmobiles.
