TEMPORARY CLOSURE
San Juan - Rio Grande National Forests
SJ - 98-06

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551, 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following is in effect on the Mancos-Dolores District of the San Juan National Forest from May 29, 1998, until further notice:

It is prohibited to use any motorized vehicle on the Doe Spring Road (Forest Development Road #506I) from its junction with Forest Development Road #506 to a point .56 mile southwest of the 506 junction [36 CFR 261.54(a)]. The section of closed road is barricaded on the ground with "Road Closed" signs and is also shown on the attached map.

Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.




