ORDER SJ-98-09
SPECIAL CLOSURE ORDER
USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS
SAN JUAN and RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FORESTS

Pursuant to Title 16 USC 551: 36 CFR 261.50 (a) & (b), the following is prohibited in the South Mineral drainage (specifically described below and shown in Attachment 1), on the Columbine District of the San Juan National Forest from June 30, 1998, until further notice:

- (1) Possessing or using a vehicle off of forest development roads [36 CFR 261.56]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Persons travelling directly off the road, to or from a designated campsite.

This area of closure is described as the South Mineral drainage of the Columbine Ranger District. The area is defined as an "E" special closure area on the San Juan National Forest map. Legal location of the closure is Township 41 North, Range 8 West, portions of Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 30, and 31. And Township 41 North, Range 9 West, portions of Sections 25, and 26. (Attachment 1).


