**ORDER #96-6  
PERMANENT CLOSURE  
SAN JUAN - RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FORESTS**

Pursuant to Title 16 USC, Section 551 and 36 CFR, Sections 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following are in effect on the Columbine District of the San Juan National Forest from April 30, 1996, until further notice:

The following are PROHIBITED:

- 1) Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions [261.58(h)].
- 2) Camping on any National Forest System lands, roads, or trails within Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32 of Township 36 north, Range 9 west, and Sections 24 (S 1/2), 25, 26, 35, and 36 of Township 36 north, Range 10 west [261.58(e)].


EXCEPT within specified sites in the Junction Creek Developed Campground.

This closure area is further shown on "Attachment 1" and is hereby made a part of this Order. This Order is being implemented to reduce the resource damage occurring within the Junction Creek Area caused by the extremely intensive camping use this area is receiving.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this Order:

- a) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- b) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
