**ORDER #90-24
SPECIAL CLOSURE
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST
REGION 2**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b):

From the period October 15 to June 15 annually, it is prohibited to possess or use motorized vehicles, except over snow vehicles operating on snow, on the following Forest Development Roads (36 CFR 261.54(a)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations.

1. Madden Peak Road #316, 7.5 miles from Highway 160 (T.36N., R.12W., Section 13, N.M.P.M.) to Dead End (T.36N., R.12W., Section 13, N.M.P.M.).
2. Echo Basin A1 Road #566 A1 from the end of the gravel (T.37N., R.12W., Section 23, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus at the West Mancos River (T.37N., R.12W., Section 23, N.M.P.M.).

The following are exempt from the provisions of this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):


- (a) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (b) Persons with a permit authorizing the use of motorized vehicles on the above roads.

The roads are being closed during this time period to prevent road damage and for safety reasons during wet and/or snowy conditions.
