ORDER #87-31
Seasonal Closure
San Juan National Forest
Region 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b):

During the period from November 1 until June 1 each year, unless otherwise posted or if the closure gates have been opened by proper authority, it is prohibited to use motorized vehicles, except snowmobiles operating on snow, on the following Forest Developed Road(s) (36 CFR 261.54 (a)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations.

Valle Seco Road, No. 653, from its junction with U.S. Highway 84, (T.33N., R.1W., Section 11, N.M.P.M.) to the private land (T.33N., R.1W., Section 29, N.M.P.M.).

Kenney Flats Road, No. 006, from its junction with U.S. Highway 84, (T.33N., R.1W., Section 14, N.M.P.M.) to its junction with U.S. Highway 84 (T.33N., R.1W., Section 19, N.M.P.M.).

Blue Creek Road, No. 012, from the end of the private land, (T.34N., R.1W., Section 13, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Porcupine Road, No. 024, from its junction with the Blanco Basin Road, No. 657, (T.34N., R.1W., Section 1, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Eightmile Mesa Road, No. 651, from the San Juan National Forest Boundary, (T.34N., R.1W., Section 16, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Nipple Mtn. Road, No. 665, from its junction with the Mill Creek Road, No. 662, (T.35N., R.1W., Section 12, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Snow Ranch Road, No. 628, from its junction with Turkey Springs Road, No. 629, (T.34N., R.3W., Section 3, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Jackson Mtn. Road, No. 037, from its junction with U.S. Highway 160, (T.36N., R.1W., Section 23, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Turkey Springs Road, No. 629, from its junction with the Piedra Road, No. 631, (T.36N., R.2 1/2W., Section 5, N.M.P.M.) to the San Juan National Forest Boundary (T.34N., R.3W., Section 3, N.M.P.M.).

East Fork Road, No. 667, from the private land boundary, (T.36N., R.1E., Section 7, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Williams Creek Road, No. 640, from its junction with the Piedra Road, No. 631, (T.37N., R.3W., Section 31, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Piedra Road, No. 631, from its junction with the Weminuche River, (T.37N., R.4W., Section 26, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Trail Ridge Road, No. 639, from its junction with the Piedra Road, No. 631, (T.37N., R.3W., Section 4, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.


Fourmile Road No. 645, from the cattleguard, (T.36N., R.2W., Section 15, N.M.P.M.) to its terminus.

Plumtaw Road No. 634, from its junction with Fourmile Road, No. 645, (T.36N., R.2W., Section 10, N.M.P.M.) to its junction with McManus Road, No. 633, (T.37N., R.3W., Section 14, N.M.P.M.).

The following are exempt from the provision of this order (36 CFR 261.50 (e)):

- (a) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (b) Person with a permit authorizing the use of a motorized vehicle on the above road (s).
- (c) Snowmobiles operating on snow.
