

**NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM AREA, ROAD AND TRAIL RESTRICTIONS  
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within the Mancos-Cortez Travel Management Planning Area on the Dolores Ranger District of the San Juan National Forest, Montezuma County, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Areas, Roads, and Trails.

The Restricted Areas are depicted on the attached maps and hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibits A.

The Restricted Roads and Trails are defined as described in the tables below, and as depicted on the attached maps, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibits B, C, D and E.

This Order is necessary to change travel management designations within the Restricted Area designated in the April 1, 2008, Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact for the Mancos-Cortez Travel Management Plan, prior to implementation of the Motor Vehicle Use Map.

**Prohibitions:**

- 1) Possessing or using any motorized vehicle off of National Forest System Roads within the Restricted Areas, as depicted in Exhibit A. 36 C.F.R. § 261.56.
- 2) Using any type of motorized vehicle on the Restricted National Forest System Roads (NFSR) or Road Segments listed in Table 1, and depicted in Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a).

**Exemptions:**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

(1) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

(3) Persons engaging in winter motorized recreation using over-the-snow vehicles such as snow machines, except in the Chicken Creek area where Special Closure Order #96-20 is still in effect. Special Closure Order #96-20 seasonally prohibits using a motorized vehicle on specified Forest Development Roads within the Chicken Creek Cross Country Ski Area from November 10 to March 15 annually.

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until October 27th, 2011, whichever comes first.

This Order rescinds and replaces Orders No. SJ-87-30 and SJ-91-16.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
