

**SPECIAL CLOSURE  
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST  
ORDER NUMBER SJ-2006-01**

Pursuant to Title 16 United States Code §551 ("U.S.C."), and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations ("C.F.R.") §261.50(a) the following act is prohibited on the San Juan National Forest from March 1, 2006 until December 31, 2011.

The purpose of this closure is to protect quality recreation opportunities for National Forest visitors.

**1. Camping for longer than 14 consecutive days in the following campgrounds [36 CFR §261 58(a)]:**



EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any federal, state or local official, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by fines of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a corporation and up to six months imprisonment, or both (18 USC 3571).
