ORDER #95-25  
SPECIAL CLOSURE  
SAN JUAN-RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC, Section 551, and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b):

From October 1, 1995, until further notice, the following is prohibited on National Forest lands within the Falls Creek Archeological Area:

Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun, EXCEPT muzzleloading black powder rifles [261.58(m)].


The Falls Creek Archeological Area is within Township 36 North, Range 9 West, sections 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 32 and 33, and is further depicted on Attachment 1 of this Order.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:


- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This closure is in accordance with the Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact for the Falls Creek Archeological Area, dated December 13, 1993.
