ORDER #93-11  
SPECIAL CLOSURE  
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST  
REGION 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a):

Beginning May 25, 1993 until further notice, the following acts are prohibited in the area described as the Falls Creek Archaeological District (T.36N.,R.9W., those portions of sections 20,21,28,29,32,33 N.M.P.M. on National Forest Lands as delineated on the attached map).

Prohibited acts include:

- a. Possessing or using any vehicle off Forest Development Roads  
36 CFR 261.56.
- b. Camping - 36 CFR 261.58(e).


The following are exempt from the provisions of this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescuer or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.

The closure does not prohibit travel through this area on Forest Development Roads.

The Falls Creek Archaeological District is being closed to off-road use and camping in order to protect the fragile archaeological resources from vandalism and destruction.
