ORDER #92-27  
SPECIAL ORDER  
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST  
REGION 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a):

From December 10, 1992 until further notice, it is prohibited to hunt deer and elk in the McPhee or House Creek Recreation Areas. This closure is enacted to provide a safe and enjoyable experience to the public recreating within these recreation areas. 36 CFR 261.58(v)

The closure of the McPhee Recreation Area is identified by the following description:

T.37N., R.16W., N-1/2 SEC. 1, those portions of National Forest lands within SEC. 2; T.37N., R.15W., those portions of National Forest lands within SECS. 6 and 7 (Big Bend Fishing area and north); T.38N., R.16W., those portions of National Forest lands not submerged within SECS. 35 and 36 (south of County Road X), N.M.P.M.


The closure of the House Creek Area is identified by the following description:

T.38N., R.15W., SW-1/4 SEC. 29, those portions of National Forest lands not submerged within the E-1/2 SE-1/4 SEC. 30 and NE-1/4 SEC. 31, and NW-1/4 SEC. 32, (first cattleguard EAST of House Creek campground and then SOUTH along the fence line), N.M.P.M.

These areas are also identified on the attached map entitled McPhee and House Creek Recreation Area Closures to Hunting.

This order is effective December 10, 1992.
