

ORDER # 91-6
SPECIAL CLOSURE
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST
REGION 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b):

From June 1, 1991 until further notice, it is prohibited to use a bicycle or motorized vehicle on the West Fork Trail FDT #561, per 36 CFR 261.55(b). This restriction applies to the following trail segment:

From the trailhead on The West Fork Road (FDR #640) to the boundary of the Weminuche Wilderness area (T.37N., R.1E., Sections 6 and 7).

The following are exempt from the provisions of this order:

- (a) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (b) Property owners using the West Fork Road beyond the trailhead for access to private property.
- (c) Persons with a permit, issued by the Forest Service, authorizing the use of mechanized equipment on the above trail segment.

This closure is for the purpose of maintaining access right-of-way for affected property owners while complying with the conditions of a public trail easement across private lands.

This order is effective June 1, 1991.
