Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b):


From July 16, 1987 until further notice, it is prohibited to possess or use any motorized vehicles on the following Forest Development Road (36 CFR 261.54(a)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations.

First Fork Road, FDR 622 from N/2 of Section 5, T.35N., R.4W. to its terminus.


The following are exempt from the provisions of this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

- (a) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (b) Persons with a permit authorizing the use of motorized vehicles on the above road.
