ORDER #91-17
SPECIAL CLOSURE
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST
REGION 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b):

From October 1, 1991 until further notice, it is prohibited to possess or use motorized vehicles off forest development roads within the following areas of the San Juan National Forest and on the following development road:

Coal Creek to Lizard Head Creek Area - T. 41N., R. 10W., N.M.P.M., sections 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34, as shown on the attached map entitled Coal Creek - Lizard Head Creek Motor Vehicle Closure and dated September 12, 1991 (36 CFR 261.56).

This closure includes Forest Development Road 205 (36 CFR 261.54(a)).

This area is designated semi-primitive, non-motorized in the San Juan National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan. In addition, the closure is needed to eliminate an identified road into the Lizard Head Wilderness, as well as to protect wet meadows from vehicle damage.


The following are exempt from the provisions of this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
