ORDER # SJ-98-03  
SPECIAL ORDER  
SAN JUAN-RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FORESTS  
REGION 2

Pursuant to Title 16 United States Code, Section 551 and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, sections 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following is prohibited on the Mancos-Dolores District of the San Juan National Forest from March 23, 1998 until further notice:

- 1) Camping on any National Forest System lands either side of County Road 25 and north of County Road 27 from the Forest Boundary within Sections 35, of Township 38 north, Range 16 west, and Sections 2, 8, 17, of Township 37 north, Range 15 & 16 west, N.M.P.M. [261.58(e)].

These closure areas are further identified on Attachment 1.

These areas have been identified to lessen user conflict, resource impacts and sanitation concerns within the McPhee Recreation Complex.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

- a) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- b) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
