

ORDER #90-23
SPECIAL CLOSURE
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST
REGION 2

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b) and 36 CFR 261.56:

From September 7, 1990 until further notice it is prohibited to possess or use motorized vehicles except snow machines operating on snow off Forest development roads within the following areas of the San Juan National Forest and on the following development road:


1. Sheep Mountain Area - T.41N., R.9W., N.M.P.M., sections 19 and 30; T.41N.,R.10W. Those portions of section 24 east of Colorado Highway 145, sections 25 and the NE 1/4 of section 36 as shown on the attached map entitled Sheep Mountain motor vehicle closure and dated 8-24-90. This includes the use of Forest Development Road 204A.1.
2. Willow Creek and Upper Fish Creek Area - T.41N., R.11W., N.M.P.M. SE 1/4 section 7, those portions of the SW 1/4 section 8, 17, 18, 19, and 20 between the Lizard Head Wilderness boundary and Forest Development Road 611 as shown on the attached map.

This closure is necessary to protect soil and water resources and prevent motor vehicle intrusions into the Lizard Head Wilderness.

The following are exempt from the provisions of this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
