ORDER NUMBER SJ-2009-14
USE OF VEHICLES OVER RESTRICTED BRIDGES
San Juan National Forest

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Roads within the San Juan National Forest, in Dolores, La Plata, San Juan, Hinsdale, Mineral and Archuleta Counties in the State of Colorado. The restricted roads listed in Attachment A and shown on attached map are hereby incorporated into this order. The purpose of this order is to protect public health and safety and prevent damage to government property.

PROHIBITIONS on the Restricted Roads:

1. Operating a vehicle in violation of speed, load, weight, length, width or other limitations as posted on National Forest System Roads listed in Attachment A and shown on attached map.

36 C.F.R. § 261.54(d).


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until December 31, 2011, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by fines of not more than \$5,000 for an individual per count or \$10,000 per count for an entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571).
