

Huron-Manistee National Forests  
Mio Commercial Haul Roads Use and Maintenance Authorizations

The Huron-Manistee National Forests received an application for temporary use and maintenance of an existing classified Forest Service Roads (FSR) and a two-track road to access a State of Michigan timber sale on the Mio Ranger District. The roads would be maintained at level 2 roads, encouraging high clearance vehicles. Maintenance would include grading, graveling a sandy incline, and cutting and brushing vegetation as needed. If allowed, a temporary forest road special use permit would be issued. The following is a description of the requested haul routes.

1. Commercial use, maintenance and minor improvement of Forest Service Road (FSR) 3081 and a two-track road as a commercial haul route for a timber sale on State of Michigan lands, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, T26N, R1W, South Branch Township, Crawford County, Michigan. No new road construction or disturbance outside the existing road area would be allowed. The road requested is from M-72 to the State of Michigan land, approximately 1,795 feet x 12 feet wide or 0.5 acre. The two-track road will be blocked following its use.
