

Huron-Manistee National Forests
Huron Shores Ranger Station
Special Use Authorization
Alcona County Department of Public Works Monitoring Wells

A ten (10) year special use authorization is recommended to be issued to Alcona County Department of Public Works (DPW) for operation and maintenance of seven (7) monitoring wells on National Forest System lands. Located on 0.01 acre in part of the SE NW of Section 7, T26N, R8E, Michigan Meridian, Alcona County, the former landfill site is currently used as a solid waste transfer station.

The recommended authorization includes access and maintenance activities in the immediate vicinity of the landfill. Maintenance activities include mowing of vegetation along road edges of the easement and maintaining the monitoring wells. Water samples are collected from the wells on a periodic basis. Access and maintenance will be the responsibility of Alcona County DPW, or their designee.

The purpose of the authorization is to respond to the existing permit which expires December 31, 2009. No new road construction will be allowed under this authorization.
