

## **MANAGEMENT AREA #26**

### Amendment to Management Direction

Apply management direction from Prescription 10 – Wild and Scenic Rivers to portions of this management area that are within the “Wild” corridor that was established by the 2006 Act. See map, page IV-184b.

Existing Management Area direction still applies in the new Wild and Scenic portions, except where it conflicts with direction from Prescription 10.
