Restricted Areas

Mount St. Helens offers you the opportunity to explore one of the world's youngest and most dynamic landscapes. Access into the heart of the blast area is restricted to help protect scientific research and to allow natural process to proceed unimpeded.

- Off trail travel is prohibited.
- Camping is NOT allowed.
- Pets and bicycles are prohibited.
- Fires are NOT allowed.
- Do not disturb or remove any natural features.
- Access into the crater is prohibited.


