



Recreation fees are an investment in outdoor recreation. Current and future generations will benefit as 95% of the funds are reinvested in the facilities and services that visitors enjoy, use, and value.

Accomplishments Provided with Recreation Fees:

- Supported campground hosts at eight of the most popular campgrounds on the forest. Hosts performed general campground maintenance and cleaning tasks and provided visitor information.
- Administered water testing program in all fee campgrounds.
- Pumped vault restrooms in fee campgrounds.
- Maintained facilities within campgrounds.
- Conducted safety patrols through campgrounds and performed heavy maintenance tasks required to open and close the campgrounds.


