


Tahoe National Forest



We Need Your Help Locating Existing Trails in the Tahoe National Forest

If you see wheeled vehicle trails or routes that are missing on the map, please draw them in with the highlighter. And then write your name and phone number next to any trail you add.

The Forest Service is beginning a process to designate OHV routes in the Tahoe National Forest. The first step is to inventory existing wheeled vehicle routes on National Forest land near Truckee. The second step will temporarily limit OHV's and other wheeled vehicles to the existing, mapped trails or small, open areas. Later steps in the process will result in a designated OHV trail system.

Mountain Bikers - Although all wheeled vehicle trails will initially be inventoried and mapped, the purpose of this process is to designate OHV routes. Mountain Bikes, like other wheeled vehicles will be limited to existing, mapped trails in the initial steps of this process. It is important that the trails you use, be identified and mapped so your use is not inadvertently lost.
