UPDATE ON EGLEY AND SILVER FIRE AREA AND ROAD CLOSURES

John Day, OR – Effective on June 30, 2009 all roads within the Egley fire area were opened to motorized access. However, to prevent resource damage, off road motorized access remains closed within the Egley fire area.

Within the Silver Fire area, all motorized access remains closed. Access in the Silver fire area is permitted by foot, horseback, or bicycle only. Travelers in the area are advised to use caution due to truck traffic from ongoing logging operations within the Silver fire area.
