PUBLIC USE RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

John Day, OR – Effective at midnight tonight, public use restrictions within the boundaries of the Malheur National Forest will be lifted. The Industrial Fire Precaution Level IFPL is 1 in both the north and south zones.

Firewood cutting is permitted on the forest except for the areas affected by area closures within the Egley Fire Area and Shake Table Complex fire area. Due to resource management and public safety these area closures remain in effect.

Although cooler temperatures have eased the current fire danger visitors are asked to continue using good fire safety practices while out in the woods.

A list of specific roads, as well as maps of the area that is affected by these closures can be obtained at Forest Service offices in John Day, Prairie City, and Hines, or by visiting www.fs.fed.us/r6/malheur.
