IFPL LOWERED AND PUBLIC USE RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

John Day, OR – Due to the recent precipitation and cooler temperatures, effective immediately, all areas within the boundaries of the Malheur National Forest will enter an Industrial Fire Precaution Level (IFPL)1.

In addition, public use restrictions on campfires outside of developed campgrounds, off-road vehicle use, and smoking are lifted. Firewood cutting is permitted except for the area affected by an area closure within the Shake Table Complex fire area.

Although cooler temperatures and recent precipitation have eased the current fire danger visitors are asked to continue using good fire safety practices while out in the woods.
