MONUMENT SALE AREA NOW TO BE CLOSED TO ALL ENTRY

John Day, OR – The Malheur National Forest awarded the Monument timber sales on May 17, announced Roger Williams, Forest Supervisor. Timber sale operations will add to the naturally hazardous conditions in this post-fire area requiring a closure order to all entry beginning May 21st. This closure affects the entire Monument fire project area. Forest visitors need to be aware that this closure prohibits walking, riding, use of motor vehicles or any other entry and access into or within this area.

A list of specific roads, as well as a map of the area that is affected by this closure can be obtained at Forest Service offices in John Day, Prairie City and Hines.
