With a stream on one side, and wetlands on the other, the existing parking has little room for campsites. Do not designate campsites at this trailhead. Place rocks to contain trailhead parking.

100	Lower NF Calispell	2022	Streamside campsite. Access route very steep and eroding. Do not designate this campsite. Close access route. Restore by planting.
