**Subject:** Removal of South Deep Harvest Units

**To:** Files

In the South Deep Management Project, three harvest units (WFL, WFS and WFV), which are located off the Aladdin Highway south of Rocky Creek Road, are scheduled for helicopter logging. Because the Forest Service does not have legal access to landings in this area and is not likely to obtain access in the near future, these units are not considered commercially viable. In addition, a private landowner objects to harvest of this area due to concerns about potential detrimental effects on two wells located near the units.

To accommodate the landowner and resolve a possible appeal issue, Forest Supervisor Rick Brazell has agreed to drop Units WFL, WFS, and WFV from selected Modified Alternative E.
