

ORDER

DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS ALONG & ADJACENT TO EIGHTMILE INTERPRETIVE TRAIL
MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 26.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on the area , roads, and trails described in this order (or exhibit A) within the Mt. Hood National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun. CFR 261.58 (m) .
- (2) Using any motorized vehicle on the forest development trails or segments listed. 36 CFR 261.55 (b) .

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.

EXHIBIT A

(A) Pursuant to the discharge of rifles/guns; all lands adjoining the Eightmile Interpretive Trail within 150 yds. of its borders and the two campgrounds on each end of the trail; Eightmile Campground & Lower Crossing Campground, in T2S, R11, section 8.

(B) Using any motorized vehicle on the Eightmile Interpretive Trail.
