

ORDER

USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS
OCCUPANCY AND USE

USDA FOREST SERVICE
MT HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads and trails described in this order within the Mt Hood National Forest from March 1st to August 1st annually.

- (1) Possession or use of a vehicle off forest development roads. 36 CFR 261.56
- (2) Camping. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
- (3) Discharging a firearm, except in the lawful pursuit of game animals as defined by state law. 36 CFR 261.58(m)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from these prohibitions:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The area known as Camas Prairie on the Barlow Ranger District. Also described as the area south of Forest Road 2120-240 and east of Forest Road 2130 located in the North 1/2 of Section 16 and Northeast 1/4 of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 10 East, W. M.
