

ORDER

USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS
OCCUPANCY AND USE

USDA - FOREST SERVICE
MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads and trails described in this order within the Zigzag Ranger District, Mt. Hood National Forest, Clackamas County, Oregon, within the area known as Old Maid Flat as described in Exhibit A, until further notice.

- (1) Possession or use of a motor vehicle off forest development roads.
36 CFR 261.56
- (2) Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun, except in the lawful pursuit of game animals as defined by state law
36 CFR 261.58 (m)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following person are exempt from these prohibitions:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This Order supersedes Forest Order MH-265-09-99, dated May 6, 1999.
