

ORDER  
OCCUPANCY AND USE  
MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b) and in order to provide for public safety and protect fragile shoreline areas, the following acts are prohibited within the area between Forest development road S-42 and Olallie Lake and on S-42 adjacent to Olallie Lake all within the Mt. Hood National Forest:

- (1) Overnight camping except in designated campgrounds (Camp 10 and Peninsula) 36 CFR 261.58(e).
- (2) Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun, 36 CFR 261.58(m).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or members of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
