Bend—Personal use firewood collection in designated woodcutting areas of the Deschutes and Ochoco National Forests and Prineville District BLM will open this Friday, May 1st and remain open through November 30, 2009.

Although some roads remain closed due to snow, many roads and firewood areas will be open on May 1st. The annual “Firewood Synopsis” will be available Friday, illustrating the areas where the public has access to collect firewood after purchasing a firewood permit.
