Dear Ms. Doughty:

I am replying to your letter dated November 17, 2009 requesting that we add some documents to the appeal record for Georgia Forest Watch. The letters that you wanted to be added have been included in the record.

- The letter, dated November 11, 2009, from Ken Arney to Rachel Doughty granting Georgia Forest Watch the right to intervene in the American Whitewater appeal was included in the Appeal documentation for the American Whitewater Appeal.
- The letter, dated November 5, 2009 from Rachel Doughty to the Appeal Reviewing Officer requesting to intervene in the American Whitewater appeal was included in the Appeal documentation for the American Whitewater Appeal.
- In attachment 3, there are three letters, dated October 27, 2009, acknowledging the receipt of Georgia Forest Watch's timely appeal. While Georgia Forest Watch submitted one appeal, the Reviewing Officer divided Georgia Forest Watch's appeal into three appeals since three separate National Forest decisions were involved. The transmittal record for the Sumter National Forest included only the acknowledgement letter for Appeal 10-08-012-0018. You should be receiving transmittal records from the Nantahala and Chattahoochee National Forests with their acknowledgement letter for the Georgia Forest Watch's appeal.
