


Welcome to El Portal Rain Forest Center!



Information and Exhibits

Enjoy the opportunity to walk over the forest canopy through the Elevated Walkway. Once inside El Portal, you will meet Forest Service staff who will be available to assist and answer your questions not only about El Portal but about all the recreational and educational opportunities offered in the Forest.

Then, discover the wonders of Tropical Forests and El Yunque in the displays found in the first level (Introduction to Tropical Forests) and in second level (Understanding the Forest, Connections, and Managing for the Future) of the visitor center.

Theater

The theater, located in the **1st level**, features a film that takes visitors to remote parts of El Yunque. For your convenience the film is shown every fifteen minutes in alternating *Spanish* (9:00 am until 4:30 pm) and *English* (9:15 am until 4:45 pm) versions.

Hours

El Portal is open 7 days a week from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm including holidays, except December 25.

Admission Fee

- ☞ \$4.00 adults
- ☞ \$2.00 Senior Citizens (65)
- ☞ children age 15 and under do not pay an entrance fee
- ☞ 50 % discount per person in groups of 15 or more people

- ☞ No pets allowed
- ☞ Enjoy all the exhibits but please be careful with them
- ☞ Food is not allowed inside the theater
