ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
CLOSURE TO PUBLIC ENTRY

ORDER NO. 20013-11

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and for the protection of the public, the following act is prohibited within National Forest System Trails or segments, blocked by a gate, sign or physical barrier, thereof located within the El Yunque National Forest.


1. Being on a Trail. 36 CFR 261.55 (a)

This order is effective from February 21, 2013 through February 21, 2018.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of the above prohibitions set forth, are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than (6) six months, or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
