ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR  
FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS**

**ORDER NO. 2013-5**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and for the protection of the public, the following act is prohibited within the El Yunque National Forest.

Possessing or operating a motorized vehicle on a National Forest System Road in Violation of the laws of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. **36 CFR 261.54(d)**


**This order is effective from February 21, 2013 through February 21, 2018.**

**Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:**

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261; Subpart A.

Violation of the above prohibition set forth, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than (6) six months, or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
