### 2010 Annual Operating Instructions – Amendment 2

This letter documents the change in grazing schedule we discussed in Alma. Since you have met your grazing intensity use rate on the Whitewater Mesa area of the Houston/Whitewater Pasture, you requested permission to move cattle to East Harve Gulch Pasture two weeks ahead of schedule by drifting them through the Hospital Pasture into the east side of the pasture. I approved this change verbally when we met and discussed the concern. This letter provides written documentation of the change in Annual Operating Instructions; changes are highlighted in red. The amended rotation schedule is shown below:

Since you are entering East Harve Gulch Pasture early, you will need to keep an eye on forage use in case there is a later need to adjust the schedule to leave East Harve Gulch Pasture early.
