**Meeting Objectives:**

A.) Obtain increased understanding of the information available regarding natural resources and existing conditions related to answering the questions:

1. "What kinds of recreation uses are appropriate and where?"
2. "How should areas with wilderness potential be managed? Roadless or not?"
3. "What are the desired conditions for recreation?"

B.) Develop a proposal to present to the entire PACs on how to answer the above questions. PACs on 3/22 charged sub-group with task of:

1. identifying incremental steps needed or preliminary questions to be answered (in order to answer questions listed above under "A"),
2. proposing a process on how the PACs will pursue answering the questions listed in "A" above (*e.g. Two breakout groups that work outside PAC meetings? Breakout groups that have work sessions during PAC meetings? Do this is one full group? etc.*)
3. providing a description of the product(s) PACs would accomplish to answer questions listed under "A" above). (*e.g. Set of criteria? Actual recommendations about what to do where? Set of maps? Narrative recommendations accompanied by maps? Etc.*)
4. Identifying any other information they would need in order to answer the questions (*e.g. examples of how people are doing it on other forests, other science info, models, etc.*)
