

Pete's Creek Trail #858

ACCESS: Travel US Highway 101 to FS Road #22/Donkey Creek Road, approximately 25 miles north of Aberdeen. Turn right and travel 8 miles northeast to junction of FS 2204 Road. Turn left and travel north 14 miles to Pete's Creek Trailhead on right side.

OPPORTUNITIES: The Pete's Creek Trail #858 provides access into the Colonel Bob Wilderness and to the summit of Colonel Bob. The summit at 4,510 feet elevation offers nice views of Quinault Lake and the Olympics.

CLOSURES: Motorized vehicles and mountain bikes are prohibited. Stock are prohibited beyond Moonshine Flats on the Colonel Bob Trail #851. No open campfires allowed above 3,500 feet inside Colonel Bob Wilderness. Obey all Wilderness regulations.

TOPO MAP: Quinault-Colonel Bob Custom Correct Map or Colonel Bob USGS Quad.

FACILITIES: A small parking lot with vault toilet and a stock unloading ramp.

SETTING: Beautiful temperate rain forest. Towering conifers including Sitka spruce, Douglas-fir, western hemlock and western red cedar provide dense shade for this trail. The forest floor is covered with lush rain forest plants.

TRAIL INFORMATION: The trail gains over 1,800 feet in 2.4 miles where it junctions with the Colonel Bob Trail #851. The Colonel Bob Trail can then be followed to the summit of Colonel Bob in an additional 1.8 miles.

PASS REQUIRED: A NW Forest Pass or a Golden Passport is required on each vehicle parked at the trailhead. Day & Annual NW Passes are available at FS offices and vendors.
