### Murhut Falls Trail #828



**ACCESS:** Travel Highway 101 to the Duckabush Recreation Area, FS Rd. #2510, 15 miles south of Quilcene. Follow road for 6.2 mi. to FS Rd. #2530, turn right on this road and drive 1.3 miles to the trailhead.

Destination	Miles	Elev.
Trailhead	0.0	800'
Trail veers to the left	0.7	1,050'
Murhut Falls Viewpoint	0.8	1,000'



**OPPORTUNITIES:** Day hiking and picture – taking. Peek-a-boo views of Mt. Jupiter and Jupiter Ridge. Good place for camera shots of the high, picturesque Murhut Falls. Practice LEAVE NO TRACE techniques during your trip.

**CLOSURES:** Trail is closed to motorized vehicles, stock, and mountain bikes.


**TOPO MAPS:** The Brothers – Mt. Anderson Custom Correct Map.

**FACILITIES:** There is a small parking area at the trailhead. The nearest potable water is at Collins Campground when the campground is open (May to September).

**SETTING:** This trail goes through second growth forest to old growth forest around the falls.

**TRAIL INFORMATION:** This trail is maintained only during the summer months. The trail is a moderate grade but stay on the trail, as hazards exist off the trail. View the falls from the top of the bank at the falls.

**PASS NOT REQUIRED:** A Northwest Forest Pass or Interagency Pass is **NOT REQUIRED** for this trail.
