ORDER NO. UMP239
FIRE REGULATIONS – PUBLIC USE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the Umpqua National Forest, as described in this order until **October 30th, 2008**, or unless sooner rescinded:

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. Except in designated recreation sites (***listed in Appendix A***) in approved fire rings, fireplaces or stoves provided. Commercial stoves fired by liquid fuel or propane are permitted. **36 CFR 261.52(a)**
2. Possessing or using a motor vehicle, except on a forest development road which is constructed and maintained for automobile use and maintained clear of flammable debris. Camping with a recreational vehicle or camper is permitted within 300 feet of a forest development road. **36 CFR 261.56**
3. **Smoking, except** within an enclosed vehicle or building, a designated recreation site (***listed in Appendix A***) or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material. **36 CFR 261.52(d)**
4. Operating an internal combustion engine other than a motor vehicle. Motors on watercraft, dredging within stream and the use of generators in designated recreation sites (***listed in Appendix A***) is permitted. **36 CFR 261.52(h)**
5. Welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame. **36 CFR 261.52(i)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local official, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a corporation or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both, Title 16 USC, Section 551 and Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
