**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
HUME LAKE RANGER DISTRICT**

**COMB FIRE
Monarch Wilderness Trails Closure**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), and in order to protect public health and safety from the threat posed by the Comb fire, the following act is prohibited within the Monarch Wilderness on the Hume Lake Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This order is effective August 5, 2005, until the Comb fire has been suppressed.

Being on the National Forest System trails listed below and shown on the attached map.

1. Deer Cove Trail (Forest Trail 30E01).
2. Happy Gap Trail (Forest Trail 30E02).
3. Choke Creek Trail (Forest Trail 30E03).

36 CFR 261.55 (a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of any official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.
